

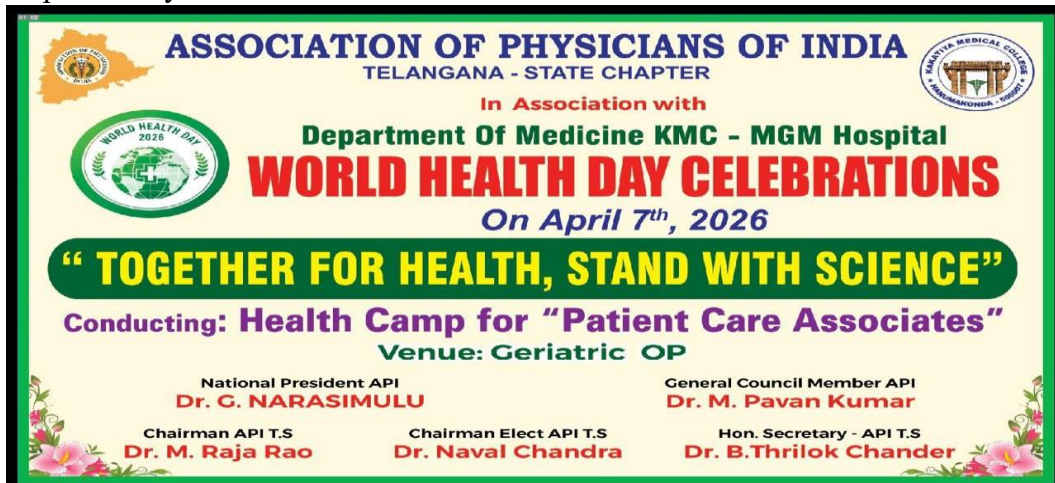
WORLD HEALTH DAY ACTIVITIES (7/04/2026) & MIDTERM CPD (19/04/2026)
